- **SAVE THE DATE** - NCOA's Annual Conference and Vanguard Awards Tribute will be held July 15-18, 2025.
- The host hotel is the Sheraton Norfolk Waterside Hotel, 777 Waterside Drive, Norfolk, Virginia 23510.

Rate for single/double occupancy is \$110/night plus applicable taxes. This rate is available 3 days prior and 3 days following the Conference upon availability. All individual room reservations must be made directly with the hotel. Reservations can be made by calling (757) 622-6664. You **MUST** specify you are with the Non Commissioned Officers Association and request the conference rate.

Reservations must be made prior to Friday, June 20 to guarantee the conference rate. Reservations made after June 20 will be subject to space/rate availability.

Check-in time at the hotel is 4:00 p.m., check-out time is 11:00 a.m. All reservations require a deposit of the first night's rate plus all applicable taxes. If cancellation is necessary, you must do so 24 hours prior to your scheduled arrival date or you will be charged for one night's room rate plus all applicable taxes. If you will be arriving after midnight, you will need to mention this when making your reservation.

Guests wishing to avoid an early check-out fee must advise the hotel of any change in their planned length of stay at or before check-in.

- The hotel is located approximately 10 miles from the Norfolk Airport. Travel from the airport to the hotel can be accomplished via Rental Cars, Taxi, and ride app companies (Lyft, Uber) which are located in the Arrivals Terminal and are available 24/7. Average taxi cost is \$30, average Uber/Lyft cost is \$30.
- Self -parking at the Sheraton Norfolk Waterside Hotel is \$25 per day plus all applicable taxes. Valet parking is available for \$35 per day plus all applicable taxes.
- Basic Guestroom Wi-Fi is complimentary.
- Event registration fee is \$200 per person through May 31. On or after June 1 registration fee is \$225. Each registration fee provides the delegate the conference registration bag and one ticket to each of the following: the Opening Icebreaker, the Awards Luncheon, Vanguard Awards Banquet, and the Breakfast with the Boards. Requests for refund of registration fees (minus a non-refundable \$50 administrative fee) must be submitted **in writing** prior to June 15.
